# Quick reference

## File01 – Learner information

NB - Remember that each of your learners may only appear once in this file

1. Learner\_Alternate\_Id and Alternative\_Id\_Type  
The best way to populate these fields is to create a student number for your learners. If a **unique** student number does not already exist at your institution then the best practise is to populate the Learner\_Alternate\_Id field with a system generated primary key field that exists on the table in your system that holds learner record. If this approach is used then set the Alternative\_Id\_Type to 537.

Identifying keys that are used across the sector to identify individuals can be mapped to the Learner\_Alternate\_Id field with an Alternative\_Id\_Type of 561.

2. Fields with a \_Code suffix and Alternative\_Id\_Type  
The appropriate codes that may be used in these fields can be found Lookup tables section of the specification.
3. Provider\_ETQA\_Id for SAS SETA training providers is always **695**.
4. Provider\_Code must always be populated with your provider code. This code usually starts with the letters 'SASS-'. Please call the VeriDataNet support desk for your institution's Provider\_Code.
5. Date\_Stamp should be the date on which the record was last updated (this helps the load procedure ignore records that do not need to be updated). If your information system does not have a last updated date field then set the Date\_Stamp value to the date on which the data is extracted.

## File51 – Learner qualification enrolment information

NB - Remember that each learner enrolment on a specific qualification may only appear once in this file

6. National\_Id, Learner\_Alternate\_Id and Alternative\_Id\_Type  
These values must be exactly the same for a specific learner as found in File01 (see notes for File01)
7. Alternative\_Id\_Type, Learner\_Achievement\_Status\_Id, Learner\_Achievement\_Type\_Id, Honours\_Classification, Learner\_Qual\_Enrolment\_Type\_Id, Learner\_Current\_Employ\_Status\_Id, Learner\_Previous\_Employ\_Status\_Id

8. Qualification\_Code  
Qualification codes that you may use are found in the lookup extract table with the naming convention:

9. Assessor\_Identifier

These values must be exactly the same for a specific learner as found in File01 (see notes for File01)
16. Alternative\_Id\_Type, Learner\_Achievement\_Status\_Id,  
Learner\_Achievement\_Type\_Id, Learner\_Course\_Enrolment\_Type\_Id  
The appropriate codes that may be used in these fields can be found Lookup tables section of the specification.
17. Course\_Code  
Course codes that you may use are found in the lookup extract table with the naming convention:  
ETQACourse[ddmmyy].txt
18. Assessor\_Identifier  
Assessor identifiers that you may use are found in the lookup extract table with the naming convention:  
ETQAAssessor[ddmmyy].txt
